Fig. 3 - Remove arms and pivot shims from post (saddle clamp may need to be loosened)

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Fig. 4 - Use bushing replacement tools as shown to replace bushings on each arm.

Fig. 5 - Tighten bolt on replacement tool to push old bushing out and new bushing into place.

Fig. 6 - Replace all components in reverse order. Torque arm bolts to 3.4 Nm (30 in-lb).






Fig. 1 - Remove bolts from arms




Fig.2 - Remove arms and pivot shims from post (saddle clamp may need to be loosened)





Fig. 3 - Use bushing replacement tools as shown to replace bushings on each arm.
